

# St. Paul Food Pantry



The June 2018 Outreach of the Month is the St. Paul Food Pantry, a ministry of our neighbors at St. Paul Lutheran Church on Lake Lansing Road. This food pantry offers food and personal needs items to their East Lansing neighbors. They are open about one day a week and serve an average of 100 people a month. The food pantry is financially supported by the congregation and by a grant from the Greater Lansing Food Bank (GLFB). ULC has a history of supporting this food pantry in three ways. First there is a food collection box by our elevator labeled "St. Paul." Second, food not distributed during our monthly Food Movers distributions is delivered to St. Paul. Third, money collected during June, will be sent to St. Paul and will be used to buy food in bulk from the GLFB. Last year at our Synod Assembly, Bishop Satterlee suggested that neighboring congregations should work together to further the mission of Christ in our world. What we are doing here together with our friends at St. Paul is just that. Outreach envelopes are available in the pew racks.
