

June Outreach of the Month Greater Lansing Food Bank

Again, this year we focus our attention on the Greater Lansing Food Bank. The Greater Lansing food bank is the organization that provides the food distributed by the Food Movers program each month at ULC.

There is still food insecurity in our area. In 2022, it is estimated that 41 per cent of the residents of Ingham County live in poverty. 45 percent of the people who receive food from the Greater Lansing food bank, are under the age of 18; with 12 percent under the age of five. Each person living in poverty in Ingham County misses more than eight meals a week.

Our congregation has been very generous in giving financially to the cause of the Greater Lansing Food Bank in the past. I sincerely thank you for being generous this month of June.
